



Weaknesses

- Condition of building stock
- River perception (history of flooding)
- Lack of "anchors" (office, retail, or amenities)
- Truck traffic
- Aging demographic

- Branding that celebrates Shelby. (e.g. Agriculture, Manufacturing, Technology)






















